

NWCG Standards for Interagency Incident Business Management, PMS 902

2025 Summary of Changes:

Chapter 10:

- Added GW.

Chapter 20:

- Lend-Lease of Incident Resources: Page 20-8, Added clarification language on lend-lease with more than one IMT, business practices and considerations.
- Supplemental Food, Drinks, Vitamins: Page 20-11, Expanded supplemental hydration to address augmenting government-provided hydration with dry mixes that are controlled distribution. Both supplemental food and drinks require a justification and concurrence from AA and INBA.
- Exhibit 19 - Equipment and Method of Hire National Standards: Page 20-20, Updated to reflect VIPR and preseason agreements.

Chapter 30:

- Property Utilization, Non-Standard items: Page 30-5, Updated language to allow replacement of government issued PPE, tools, and gear that is non-standard in some circumstances. The completion a Property Loss or Damage Report – Fire Suppression, OF 289 is a requirement for the replacement of government property loss or damage on suppression incidents.
- Recycling at Incident Base: Page 3-7, Recycling is no longer required.

Chapter 40:

- Incident Agency Coordination: Page 40-1, Written guidelines regarding final incident package (IFP) and performance standards provided to IMTs should be supplemented to meet agency guidelines while aligning with NWCG Finance Electronic Files Management standards.
