Description

The numerical identification of an aircraft, also known as a registration number for an aircraft, as displayed on the aircraft's tail section.

Business Rules

- 1. Between 4-14 characters (see next bullet for dashes).
- 2. Allow one dash (-), not multiple (for National Guard resources only).
- 3. Alpha characters must be upper case.
- 4. Not null for resources whose Kind is Aircraft.
- 5. Can be null for aircraft groups.
- 6. Must be unique for a valid resource.
