

Final Fire Size

Status: Approved

Description

Number of acres within the final fire perimeter polygon of a specific, individual incident, including unburned and unburnable islands.

Business Rules

1. As a minimum, fires greater than one acre will be reported to the unit acre.
2. As a minimum, fires less than one acre will be reported to the tenth of an acre.
3. For fires that have a fire perimeter mapped in GIS, the final fire size reported should equal the fire size calculated from the GIS perimeter (Fire History polygon), commensurate with the required level of precision.
