Status: Approved

Description

The vertical distance of an object or point measured relative to the ground directly beneath it.

Business Rules

- 1. Height above ground level in feet.
- 2. Scale of 1 decimal place.
- 3. Feature height should always be calculated to measure the tallest part of the features.
For example, the height of a windmill feature will be the height of the blade as opposed to the height of the tower.
- 4. Null value is acceptable.
