

Incident Quarantined Indicator

Status: Approved

Description

Indicates whether an incident record (of event type WF) is potentially in conflict with another incident (of event type WF), based on the incident conflict detection rules.

Business Rules

1. All 5 conditions must be met to result in a potential conflict:
 1. Both incidents must be of IncidentTypeKind 'FI'
 2. Both Incidents must not be IncidentTypeCategory 'CX'
 3. The FireDiscoveryDateTime of the added incident must be within 6 hours (< 6 hours) of the potential parent incident
 4. The Geometry (SHAPE@XY) of the added incident must be within ½ miles (< ½ miles) of the potential parent incident
 5. Both incidents must have either different values for DispatchCenterID OR different values for CreatedBySystem

For example, Incident A DispatchCenterID = IDBOC and Incident B DispatchCenter = IDBOC, but A was created by Wildcad and B was created by Firecode, the two incidents would be flagged as potential conflicts.

Permissible Values

Permissible values for Incident Quarantined Indicator

Label	Alternate Label	Code	Literal
True	Incident in conflict - quarantined	Y	1
False	Incident not in conflict - not quarantined	N	0

For data exchange, use the **Literal** value (e.g., "1"), not the Code.
