

Local Incident Identifier

Status: Approved

Description

A number or code that uniquely identifies an incident for a particular local fire management organization within a particular calendar year.

Business Rules

1. A Local Incident Identifier must be assigned to only one fire for a particular local fire management organization and within a particular calendar year.
2. As needed, leading zeroes should be padded to the Local Incident Identifier to fulfill the 6-character minimum length when fire report data is exchanged (exported).
3. Every fire must be assigned a Local Incident Identifier.
4. Alphanumeric with hyphens or periods.
